

Revised Airplane/Airport Instructions

Deplane through Jetway and turn left proceeding down a long hall. At the end turn right and just as you go through the open doors there should be an airport worker directing foreigners to their immediate left. You will follow this to the end where there is a desk and you will pay the \$10.00 per person entry fee. They will put a little sticker on the back of your green paper. From there you proceed around to the customs desks where you will get your passport stamped and they will take the top portion of the green paper and return to you the lower smaller portion. **DO NOT LOSE THIS!!**

You leave customs desks to your right and turn left and then left again down the stairs/escalator to baggage carrousel. To your left will be the desks where you will pay \$2.00 U.S. for a luggage cart if you need one then proceed to the baggage area. Here, to your right are nice clean restrooms and you should make this stop before exiting. It's an hour and ½ ride to the house.

There will be employees wanting your baggage tickets to collect your bags for you. If you choose to do this they will need a tip. Keep in mind that if a bag goes around a few times and not claimed they are pulled off and placed off to the side. So if you are not seeing your bag(s) you will want to check there too.

After you've gotten your bags you will proceed towards the exit and here there will be agents wanting to see your baggage tickets to compare to your luggage. When done, turn left and there is a desk where an agent will take your white customs form. Turn right and right again and this will take you to the outside.

Once outside (we will be right outside and if you are a new team we will be holding up a Feed My Sheep Sign) there will be more employees in gray trying to "touch" your bags or take the cart from your hands to help get it to the truck. If you do not want help, just keep saying "NO MERCI". If you do want help, make sure you tell the guy you pick (and look at his name tag) and tell him "I only pay you"!! If you get help, a tip is about \$2.00 per bag. But **DO NOT PAY** anything until all bags are in truck.

SPENDING MONEY

We strongly suggest bringing smaller denomination bills (5's, 10, and 20's). Once exchanged, it cannot be exchanged back to **U.S.**

*****IMPORTANT*** ANY U.S. BILLS MUST NOT HAVE ANY TARES AT ALL!!!!!! THEY WILL NOT EXCHANGE IT IF IT DOES. NO MATTER HOW SMALL A TARE.**
