

Haiti Medical/Dental Clinic Solar and Power Project

Dear Friend

In 2015, our small group bible study embarked on a mission trip to Haiti. The primary purpose was to provide a 2 day free Medical and Dental clinic in a small mountain town there called Piate'. We had a very successful time and learned of many needs of the clinic and surrounding area.

For most of people in this area this was the first time that a Dentist had ever visited the people of the village and surrounding villagers, some had walked 3 to 4 hours, one way, just to have their bad teeth pulled.

One of the most noticeable items missing was the lack of available dentistry and dental education. Over the course of the next year, prior to our second trip in 2016, we discussed the needs and plotted a course that would achieve a fully capable Dental and Medical clinic to support the area. Our first step was the purchase of a portable dental chair, which we dismantled and placed into 4 suitcases, reassembled in Haiti, and delivered to the clinic. This replaced the plastic patio chair we used the previous year.

With this new piece of equipment we were able to entice a dentist from Port-Au-Prince to travel the 3 hours, one-way, and provide basic, yet still primitive dentistry needs to the local people once a month.

This year we acquired a portable dental machine that will add the ability of the dentist to not just check and pull teeth but now clean, drill/fill cavities, as well as do root canals. Now teeth can be saved.

However, we ran into a problem. The old generator for the entire clinic could not produce enough watts to run the portable machine. In addition the electrical wiring that ran throughout the clinic was, in brief, catastrophic.

So for this year we are trying to raise funds to provide a self-sustaining Solar system, re-wiring for the clinic, and a new and high quality generator.

Our goal for the project is \$8,000 and will provide them 24 - hour availability.

12 Deep Charge Batteries	\$1200
Charge Converter	\$ 500
5500 Watt Generator	\$ 500
Labor for Installation and Wiring	\$1000
